We ask that the children read daily for at least 20 minutes. Please record every time that you read with your child in their reading record. This can include fiction and non-fiction texts (books, magazines, newspapers etc). Part of each reading session should include discussing what the child has read, any new vocabulary and answering questions about the text. If you would like some question prompts to assist you with this, then please speak to one of our team.	Spellings will usually be given out on a Monday. This will consist of a look, cover, check sheet to be completed and returned to school by the Thursday. Please ensure that your child practises these words throughout the week so that they know how to spell each word and are ready for their spelling test on Thursday / Friday.	Children are expected to spend at least 25 minutes a week practising their times tables using Times Tables Rockstars. During the summer term, children in year 4 will take part in the statutory Multiplication Check for Year 4 where they will be expected to answer multiplication questions up to 12 x 12. They will have a time limit of 6 seconds per question. Other good online games to help with times table practice are 'Daily 10 – Top Marks' and 'Hit the Button – Top Marks'.	PE will be on Wednesday morning and Thursday afternoons. Please could you ensure that your child has appropriate PE kit, both for indoor and outdoor PE. This includes suitable footwear (trainers) and warm clothing for outdoor sessions. Earrings must be removed and long hair must be completely tied up. Children should not be wearing any other jewellery. Please could you ensure that PE kits are taken home each week to be washed and then returned to school the following week.	Please ensure that your child is dressed appropriately for the weather, including a coat for when it is raining. Please make sure that all items of clothing are named. All children should bring in a water bottle every day. If you have any questions, please feel free to talk to one of our Y4 team – we are here to help and support you.
