


<p>English</p> <p>In English, we will be exploring the tale of Hansel and Gretel. We will be writing a setting description describing a Candy House and then a diary recount, writing as if we are Hansel.</p>	<p>Maths</p> <p>In Maths, we will continue to introduce the concept of multiplication. We will be learning about equal groups, repeated addition and arrays. After this, we will move onto division. We will learn all about sharing and grouping. Then we will undertake a shape unit where we will learn about both 2D and 3D shapes. Following this, we will revisit addition and subtraction of two-digit numbers.</p>	<p>Science</p> <p>In Science, the topic is Materials. We will explore how they are used in everyday life. In the second half of term, we will begin to learn more about living things and their habitats.</p>

Learners will begin to understand what data means and how this can be collected.</p>	<p>RE</p> <p>In RE, we will be answering the question, ‘What do Sikhs believe?’ We will be learning about Sikh families and thinking about how Gurdwaras bring people together, the 5 K’s and Sikh festivals.
