| <p>English PVPG unit – consolidation of punctuation and grammar Non-Chronological Report – learning about features of a non-chron and using these to write a report about their own Galapagos animal. We will also learn about how living things produce offspring and how features may be inherited. Electricity – the children will learn what electricity is, how batteries, how the brightness of a lamp or volume of a buzzer may vary depending on voltage. The children will also learn to draw circuits using symbols.</p> |
| <p>History Monarchs through time – we will be learning about 5 different monarchs since 1066: William I, Henry VIII, Elizabeth I, Charles II, Victoria I. We will learn how they came to be in power, significant events which happened during their reign and how far their power reached.</p> | <p>Year 6</p>  <p>Autumn Term 2025</p> | <p>Geography Mountains, Earthquakes and Volcanoes - we will be learning about the layers of the Earth and tectonic plates.
