<p>We expect the children to read for at least 20 minutes a minimum of 5 times per week.</p> <p>Please log reading in the Reading Diary. Both children and adults can log reading in the diaries.</p> <p>Children's reading will be monitored in school.</p>	<p>Spellings will be sent home weekly on a Monday and are expected to be completed and returned the following Monday.</p> <p>The children will need to complete the Look, Cover, Write, Check sheet. We would then like the children to choose 5 of the words and write these in sentences on the reverse of the sheet.</p> <p>The children can also practise the spelling words using the Purple Mash quiz online for the relevant term and week.</p>	<p>The children are expected to complete at least 30 minutes of Times Tables Rock Stars.</p> <p>This will be monitored weekly in school.</p> <p>If there are difficulties with accessing the internet at home, please let us know so that we can arrange some time in school to access TT Rock Stars.</p>	<p>PE is taught on a Monday and Friday afternoon. This will comprise of an indoor session and an outdoor session.</p> <p>Please ensure that PE kits are weather appropriate. Children must have suitable footwear to change into for outdoor PE.</p> <p>Earrings and other jewellery must be removed for PE.</p> <p>Mrs Hanworth's class will continue to swim on a Monday afternoon with their final swimming session being 11th May.</p>	<p>Monday 11th – Paper 1: Grammar, spelling and punctuation Paper 2: Spelling Tuesday 12th – Reading paper Wednesday 13th – paper 1: arithmetic Paper 2: maths reasoning Thursday 14th – Paper 3: maths reasoning</p> <p>On these days, we will open the doors at 8:30am so that the children can come and settle in.</p> <p>If you feel that your child is getting overly worried about the upcoming SATs, please speak to the class teacher who will be able to offer support and reassurance.</p>	<p>Please ensure that all clothing is named.</p> <p>Children will need a water bottle in school each day and they may also bring a healthy snack to have at break time.</p> <p>Children are allowed to wear a single stud or pair of stud earrings (hoops or dangly earrings are not permitted). No other jewellery is permitted neither is nail polish.</p> <p>If your child brings a mobile phone to school, it must be switched off as they enter the school premises and handed into the teacher so it can be put away in the cupboard. It can then be collected at the end of the day and again not switched on until they have left the school grounds.</p>
