<p>We ask that children read at least 5 times a week for 15 minutes. Please record every time that you read with your child in their reading record.</p> <p>Part of each reading session should include discussing what the child has read, any new vocabulary and answering questions about the text. If you would like some question prompts to assist you with this, then please speak to one of our team.</p>	<p>We will send spelling homework home on Monday every week. This is to be completed and handed back to class by Friday of the same week. There will be house points for children who bring these in for marking.</p> <p>Often the spellings will follow a pattern or rule and children should be encouraged to see if they can spot any patterns and consider which others words follow the rule.</p> <p>Please ensure that your child practises these words throughout the week so that they know how to spell each word.</p>	<p>We will be doing lots of competitions on Times Tables Rockstars. We expect children to do 20 minutes a week of practice which we will monitor weekly.</p>	<p>PE days are Tuesdays and Fridays. Please bring indoor and outdoor kits and keep them in school (including suitable trainers). Please could you ensure that PE kits are taken home each week to be washed and then returned to school on Monday morning.</p> <p>Remember to remove earrings, tie hair up and bring socks to wear with trainers if coming to school in tights. Children cannot tape earrings so they must be removed and long hair must be completely tied up. Children should not be wearing any other jewellery.</p>	<p>Please ensure all your child's belongings are named including uniform, coats, jumpers and bottles.</p> <p>Please ensure that your child is dressed appropriately for the weather, including a coat for when it is raining.</p> <p>All children should bring in a water bottle every day.</p>
