


<p>English</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - We will be looking at non-fiction, writing persuasively to encourage Britons to join Boudicca to battle back against the Romans! We'll use exaggerated / emotive language, commands and rhetorical questions. - We will then look at how we can recount the steps of a science experiment: 'Can water travel through a flower's stem?', focusing on writing facts and describing the process using adverbials of time, place and manner. 	<p>Maths</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - We will begin by looking at time, duration and timetables before moving onto data handling. We will be interpreting pictograms and bar charts. Children will then look at measures of length including measuring and calculating perimeter. We will also work on height, weight and capacity. 	<p>Science</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - We will be learning about light and how shadows are formed. We will look at how the time of day affects the size of our shadows, and how we can alter the size of our shadow by varying a light source.
<p>History</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - We will explore The Roman Empire and its impact on Britain. The focus will be on Power (including the power of technology and building, power over tribes, and power struggles with the Ancient Britons), Invasion (including the spread of the Roman Empire led by its Emperors), and Civilisation (including a study of the cities, architecture, laws, culture and art in Roman times). 	<p>Year 3</p>  <p>Summer Term 2026</p>	<p>PE</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - We will be focusing on a range of skills and teamwork through Athletic Activities and Country Dancing. - Athletic skills will be practiced through running, jumping and throwing.

They will focus on managing safety and risk, relationships, healthy lifestyles and digital lifestyles. 	<p>Art</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Children will be using a range of paint techniques to create backgrounds for effect before combining painting and printmaking techniques.
<p>Computing</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Pupils will explore sequencing in programming through Scratch, using motion, sound and event blocks to create their final project - to make a representation of a piano. 	<p>RE</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - We will explore the importance of light in different religions of the world. - We will be learning about Muslim beliefs. Pupils will explore beliefs in relation to the Five Pillars of Islam. 	<p>Design Technology</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - We will work with textiles to see how they can repurpose an item of clothing.
